**Procedures for Election Day (27 January 2019)**

1. The election will be held on Sunday 27 January 2019 at Impression Event Venue, Milner Road, London E15 3AD
2. Polling will start at 2.30 pm and continue until 6.00pm.
3. Eligible member must provide proof of identity by providing membership Photo ID card.
4. No posters, leaflets or other written materials are allowed to display or distribute within the polling area.
5. No one is allowed to advice, canvass or give direction to the voters for casting their vote within polling area.
6. No candidates will be allowed in polling area apart from casting his/her vote.
7. Every voter is allowed to cast his/her vote once only. If they need any assistance or clarification it must be raised with the staff or members of the election commission.
8. In case of any doubt of double casting or doubt on any voters for attempting to cast vote more than once the agents may raise with evidence with any members of the election commission/ polling officers.
9. If any voter attempt to vote more than once may be treated as an offence, therefore he/she may be referred for appropriate action.
10. The ballot papers may become void in case of multiple cross/tick on the ballot papers.
11. LBPC Members who are out of country can apply for Email voting to election commission to a dedicated email which is only accessible by the commissioners. Members must provide their airline e-ticket as proof. Email to apply for e-voting is : [LBPC@journalist.com](mailto:LBPC@journalist.com)

12. Members of the election commission are entitled to liaise with the staff or members of management committee of LBPC for any queries or clarification required.
13. No interference is allowed from any individual during the running of election.
14. Maximum 2 observers will be allowed during polling time to observe polling arrangements from each Alliance.
15. During counting votes maximum 2 observers will be allowed to observe counting from each Alliance and 1 observer from each independent candidates.
16. No camera or mobile phone will be allowed in polling area. If anyone seen taking pictures their vote may be void.
17. Any decision involving the election taken by the election commission is final.
